Main Purpose of the Job

The incumbent will be responsible for providing Intermediate life support pre-hospital medical care services within the protocols and standards in accordance with the company guidelines and the provisions of the Botswana Health Professions Council as well as assist in the training department with delivery of scheduled First Aid courses.

Key Performance Areas

- Responds and provides emergency medical service at ECT Level.
- Provides road and aeromedical evacuations.
- Ensures accurate and effective handover from one to another.
- Ensures that base facilities and services are maintained at shift the highest operational level including medicines and equipment.
- Maintains vehicles and ensures they are in good working condition.
- Checks and reports the availability of supplies as necessary by reporting any shortage of supplies or faults of medical equipment immediately.
- Consults and escalates medical case management to the Advanced Life Support Paramedic as appropriate.
- Assists the Training Department with delivery and marketing as required.
- Immediately reports any damage, defects, incidents that assigned vehicle may have incurred or have been involved in.
- Submits Medical case documentation and hand over reports and signed off by all crew members at the end of each shift.
- Implement EMS approved standard operating procedures.
- Prepare and maintain records and reports on all patients and services as required and in line with company and professional standards.
- Respond as required to customer feedback.
- Continually update self on latest EMS protocols
- Ensures that all medical supplies for the ambulance are monitored and replenished accordingly as per the Handover check list.

- Ensures that all consumables used during a case are recorded and replaced after the case.
- Performs any other duties as may be assigned from time to time.

Job Requirements & Experience

- Three (3) years' work experience as an ECT Paramedic.
- Active driving of Class B for at least 2 years.
- Diploma in Emergency Care Technology from a recognized institution.
- Must have a valid and clean Class B driver's license.
- Must have BLS for Health Care providers.
- Public Drivers Permit Holder and Class C1 are a requirement.
- Registered with Botswana Health Professions Council.
